Neuroshow 2026

organized by the Jim Foundation

1. The poster session (hereinafter referred to as the Session) is an integral part of the Neuroshow 2026 conference (hereinafter referred to as the Conference), which will take place on 9–10 October 2026 in Warsaw. The session will be held in its own separate room, and will be a „quiet session”, meaning that no presentations will be held for a sitting audience in an auditorium. The detailed conference programme will be published by 30 September 2026.
2. Posters submitted to the competition may be scientific posters prepared by PhD candidates and academic staff of universities who were awarded their doctoral degree no earlier than 5 years prior to the conference. Posters may be individual or collaborative work prepared by a team of no more than five people.
3. A poster submitted to the competition may present a topic related to broadly understood neurodiversity or any neurodivergent condition (e.g. autism spectrum, ADHD, dyslexia, etc.). The subject of the poster should include research conducted by the members of the team. The poster should present results obtained and analysed by the time of submission.
4. Participation in the competition is free of charge. Participants whose posters are selected by the organizer to be presented at the Conference are required to pay a fee of 170 EUR within the deadline specified by the organizer.
5. Conditions for participation:
 - a. submission of the application to participate in the Session before midnight on the 30th of June 2026, by completing the application form available at ([link to the application form](#)) and submitting an abstract of the poster (format: .doc, .docx, .pdf), max file size: 512 kB, in English.
 - b. submission by 31 August 2026 to the email address posters@jim.org of a signed declaration including consent to the processing of personal data, consent to the recording of the competition proceedings, consent to the use of image, and consent to the use of photographs from the Conference for marketing purposes, including publication on social media ([template of the declaration](#))
 - c. submission by 31 August 2026 of the digital version of the poster, meeting the following requirements:
File format: .jpeg, .png, pdf
Image format: 9:16
File size : max 10 MB
Language: english
Online cover resolution (fixed) : 640px x 640px
 - d. submission on 9 October 2026, at the Conference venue, of a printed version of the poster. The poster must meet the following requirements:

Digitally designed and printed in full colour

Language: English

6. No more than 30 posters will be qualified for the poster session.
7. The competition entries will be presented to Conference participants and published on the Conference website, and will be available to registered Conference participants until 31 December 2026.
8. The competition will be resolved during the Conference, and the winner will be selected by: a vote of Conference participants (1 participant – 1 vote; participants of the poster session also take part in the voting), conducted during the Conference, or
9. Information about the winner will be published on the Foundation's social media channels and on the Neuroshow 2026 Conference website.
10. The winner of the poster session will receive a prize in the form of free participation in the NeuroShow 2027 Conference and the opportunity to give a presentation at that Conference. The topic of the winner's presentation and the conditions of participation as a speaker will be determined in cooperation with the organizer.
